RHENISH HISTORY CORNER

(Series no.33)

This week we will take a look at a popular sport at Rhenish Primary: Tennis!

Tennis at Rhenish.

In 1920, while Ms Wright was principal, the first tennis court was built at the school on the Braak. Then in 1925, under Ms Price, the lower part of the grounds was levelled to accommodate two more tennis courts. When Ms Siggs was principal, a plot of ground was acquired across the Mill Stream, where the Checkers parking lot now stands. Here two more courts were established. After the Provincial Administration acquired the property, the tennis courts were removed and the surface was evened out to create a parking lot for Checkers Supermarket.
